LOCATION

In the last 20 years an industrial area, still enlarging, has been settled. The climate is generally quiet and poor of rain, although the temperature changes are fast and short, due to the wind from the Balkan area. In spite of the fact that our area has good road, railways, air and maritime facilities, and that it has strategic links with the East-Mediterranean and Balkan countries, it is quite distant from the so-called heart of Europe. Molfetta is known in the last years for an important growth in terms of commercial activities and attractions, thanks to the recent creation of a huge commercial area (outlet and shopping mall), provided of shops, national chains, outlet, luna park, hard discount, cinemas and so on. At the same time in the old city town many restaurants, bars, and youth centers are very crowed during the weekend and in the evening.

Molfetta's climate is generally mild and sunny, thanks to its geographical location. But beware! Temperatures can vary rapidly due to the Balkan wind.

It is a no-profit association, born at unformal level in 2013, thanks to a group of members moving to Apulia region after many mobility experiences. The aim of the association is to promote and support mobility abroad, contacts, exchanges and meetings at international level; to promote mutual tolerance and intercultural sensitivity among young people; to support the unformal process of European integration in our community. In addition, InCo-Molfetta activities are addressed to create intercultural abilities and non-formal competences for all the participants.

- When you arrive in Molfetta, you have to pay a deposit of 100 € just in case of damages.
- The lodging choice will be always decided by InCo. Volunteers will have to respect the rules of the structure and the environment where they live.
- There are possibilities for the volunteers to have their meal at home, which is fully furnished with kitchen. So, in this case an additional amount of money will be provided corresponding to 150 euros.



PROFILE OF THE VOLUNTEER

You should be very motivated, patient and tolerant to work in an international environment, passionate for the activities we offer and not just for Italian stereotypes (such as pizza, dolce vita and sun!). We need a very flexible person to unexpected changes of activities, lodging and programmes seen the new international scenario. You should be very creative and ready to suggest new ideas. Ability and experience in editing podcasts, music, video, photos and posters will be a plus. Finally, we would like you are aware this is not just travelling to another country, but it is a full time learning experience.

PROPOSED ACTIVITIES FOR VOLUNTEERS

- Actively participation to Youth Exchanges in Molfetta and other projects carried out by InCo. During those projects the volunteer is required to live with the groups of participants for one week or more, being part of the staff and taking care of the other participants.
- Help to prepare: Info meetings (Every Tuesday you will go to one Youth Center in Molfetta to give information about Erasmus+/ESC to youngsters)/ Seminars (The volunteers will go to different schools to promote the different Erasmus+/ESC programs)/ monitoring and final evaluation for sending and hosting participants (in InCo office and in other locations)/Local Events
- Support the activity of our local webradio "Radio Fgen". We need your ability for: Editing podcasts, music and video / Creating posters and graphics with specific softwares / Recording podcasts
- Communication activities: You will have to update the Instagram/Facebook profile of InCo ⊠ Try to make every day a post, or an Instagram story.
- Creation of flyers/posters: If we plan to make an event, we need your help to create posters and flyers.
- Cooperation in the project related to "fake news", hate speech, cyber bullying.
- Possibility to organize and manage short courses (to be held in InCo office or in the partner school sites): music, handcraft, languages, etc.
- Participation to complementary activities with all the other volunteers, such as "Testo a Fronte", "International Evening", "Cultural excursions", ecc...
- Cooperation in organizing public events in the city, such as exhibitions, competitions, prizes, cineforum, etc.



MISSION 2: TRULLO BEACH

The Camper Club Trullo Beach in Molfetta is located outside the city, on the seaside between Molfetta and Giovinazzo and provides services and resting area for campers and travelers.

The main goal of Trullo Beach is promotion of sustainable and solidarity tourism, by carrying ut recreational and sports initiatives and activities, facilitating cultural exchange between travelers and locals, providing inclusion and adequate assistance to those with fewer opportunities and with disabilities, taking care of our environment and biodiversity.

The main objectives of the organization are to:

- Promote and coordinate different outdoors sports activities, tourist camping, gardening, grilling, etc...With care and special attention to the protection of nature and sea.
- Support children and people with disabilities. The organization offers easy access to the sea and provides opportunities of playing outdoor and learning in a non-formal environment.
- Collaborate with other associations and develop some environmental and social projects.

Tasks of the volunteer :

- The volunteers will work generally 36 hours/week from 9 a.m to 13 p.m and in the afternoon also from 16 p.m to 19 p.m.
- Assist the staff members in organizing and preparing the area of the bar, beach, leisure and relax space such as chairs and tables, books, games, grill etc..
- Organize and carry out activities for children, such as energizers, reading, drawing, playing, sports...
- Support and assist children or adults with disabilities at the beach or in using services of the organization, coordinating and organizing recreational activities for them.

- Making arts and crafts out of objects and rubbish found on the beach, such as bottles, taps, nets...
- Taking part in cleaning initiatives, either the sea or the nearby area.
- Supporting the staff in everyday activities, by occasionally preparing some typical dishes from volunteer's home country, doing barbecue, gardening, etc....
- Creating promotional material and digital content such as photos, videos, posters, brochures, blogs... Updating social media channels and web site.
- Organizing language laboratories and a sort of "free walking tours" in Molfetta for foreign travelers.

MISSION 3: AUSER

Auser" is a non-profit organization committed mainly to promoting the active aging of the elderly and enhancing their role in society. While the main focus lies primarily on the elderly, the organization is open to building fruitful relations and dialogue between generations, nationalities. The main objectives of AUSER:

- To improve the quality of life of adults and the elderly.
- To combat all forms of social exclusion and discrimination, in particular against migrants, the elderly and women of all ages.
- To support those fragile and disadvantaged and reduce inequalities widespread in modern society.
- To spread the culture and initiatives of solidarity and participation.
- To promote the value of experiences, skills, creativity and ideas of the elderly and to develop and foster relationships of solidarity and exchange with the younger generations.

Tasks of the volunteer :

1 - In the Project "Colto e Mangiato":

 To support the maintenance of the "public garden" where youngsters and elderly grow and cultivate plants and herbs, vegetables and fruits.

- To support the organization of workshops and encounters with locals 2x per week, keep a record of activities and participants, record videos and make photos, take an active part in cooking laboratories and prepare typical dishes using the products from the garden, etc...
- 2 To support and participate in leisure activities with elderly, f.e. playing cards, playing board games, chess, cooking, singing, dancing, going for a walk...

3 - To help and collaborate in organizing events and celebrations, especially during public and religious holidays, such as Christmas, New Year, Easter, Halloween, Carnival...

• Preparing and organizing space and venue, preparing typical dishes and sweets, organizing dinner, plays, dance, making arts and crafts...

4 - To participate in distribution of food and personal care products to those in need e.g. going to the supermarkets and organizations which provide these products, organizing packages, keeping a record of families and deliveries...

5 - To make digital material and content, such as photos, videos, blogs, posters, brochures; promoting events and activities of the organization, keeping updated social media profiles and website...

6 - To assist and support the promotion of "Active aging" through activities such as playing sports, yoga, meditation, language courses, course of basic digital skills etc...

• An important part play the complementary activities, where all the volunteers take part and are actively involved with their creativity and ideas.







MISSION 4: XFARM -AGRICOLTURA PROSSIMA

XFARM Agricoltura prossima is a project by Cooperativa Sociale Qualcosa di Diverso, born after the experience of Laboratorio Urbano ExFadda in San Vito dei Normanni: a social, ecological and multicultural farm created from the recovery of lands confiscated from the mafia in Apulia.

We are a group of young people under 35 committed to transforming 50 hectares of lands, once a symbol of illegality and unsustainable agriculture, into a "Manifesto Farm" of good social, ecological, and cultural practices. We've been creating an original rural hub capable of contributing to the local development of the Alto Salento area, through the creation of jobs, wellbeing for the community and ecosystem improvement. We believe in the territory of Puglia and in its resources, too often unexpressed and squandered.

We look at XFARM and its lands as a common good, a big public park opened to the community of the territory. We want to put into action a new vision of social and regenerative agriculture, alternative to the intensive and unsustainable models. We promote the regeneration of soil and the recovery of biodiversity, we foster circular economy practices, job integration of fragile workers and the production of good quality and healthy food, we organize social and cultural events for the local community, we support the scientific research and agricultural projects of young people of our territory.

Tasks of the volunteer :

To provide support to the agricultural activities within the farm, notably: management of the vegetable crops and community garden, the olive groves, the vineyard and the henhouse.

Additional activities will be:

1 - Support to the activities of planting, management and experimentation related to the project "XFARM Agroforestry" aimed at increasing biodiversity and regenerating the soil.

2 - Support to the designing and organization of Manifesto SuperCamp, a week-long festival focused on agro-ecology related training and workshops, seminars, research, events and camping in the nature. 3 - Support to the organization of public events, seminars, workshops, training lessons open to the local community and the company's partners.

4 - Support to the organization of social activities aimed at raising awareness on agro-ecological issues, those referred to the social fight against the mafia and local development.

San Vito dei Normanni, in the heart of Puglia :

The project will take place in San Vito dei Normanni, a city of around 20.000 inhabitants in the heart of Apulia. It's located at about 20 km from Brindisi, 14 km from Ostuni, about 12 km (16 minutes) from the wonderful marine natural reserve of Torre Guaceto, and 40 km from Lecce. From Brindisi it's easy to reach the major touristic areas and urban centres in the region by public ransportation. (train, bus, plane). During summer the city is bustling with people enjoying cultural events and other social activities organized by the local community.

MISSION 5: SCUOLA SECONDARIA DI PRIMO GRADO "R. MONTERISI"

Monterisi secondary school is in Bisceglie, a community of Apulia. Junior Secondary School Monterisi 783 students from 10 to 13 years and a staff of 84 teachers. The school is equipped with a gym, an auditorium, an IT lab, a language lab and wi-fi connection. It is one of the few schools in Italy with two musical sections where pupils learn to play various instruments (piano, guitar, clarinet, violin, cello, flute, trumpet) and it has a school orchestra formed by more than 100 pupils.

Tasks of the volunteer :

1 - Conduct a Multicultural Club in English language to foster youth cultural development.

- During English language lessons, for one hour a week, a Multicultural club will be set up in collaboration with the language teacher who will have the aim of fostering a greater knowledge and understanding of the various cultures of the world among students.
- 2 Participate at CLIL workshops in 2nd and 3rd classes.
- During the curricular hours, volunteers will work alongside the teachers of the various disciplines to promote the English language as a vehicular language of knowledge. The volunteer, in collaboration with the curricular teacher, will design a learning unit of the specific subjects, such as history, literature, geography, mathematics, science, art, music that will be proposed to the class in English.
- 3 Support students in everyday lessons, identifying strategies to encourage inclusive student participation and engagement in classroom activities.

4 - Participate to afternoon activities including art, music, sports, environmental education.

- 5 Participate to outings and study visits
- 6 Participate to a course of Italian.
- 7 Help the students with their homework.
- 8 Cooperate with local no-profit organizations.

Living in Gdynia

The Missions take place in Gdynia (250 000 inhabitants) and Rumia, a small town 10 minutes from Gdyna. Gdnynia together with Gdansk and Sopot builds agglomeration called Tricity (750 000). Gdynia is a young city with modernistic architecture, built in the early XX century. It attracts many tourists and inhabitants with beautiful beaches in the city centre, music and film festivals and a couple of universities.

Gdynia ESC volunteers live in a few flats in different districts of the city and work in more than 10 different locations (libraries, NGOs, neighbourhood centres etc). Together with their mentors (local volunteers) they create a large, international and lively community of around 35 young people.

Gdynia is a city in northern Poland and a seaport on the coast of the Baltic Sea. Rich in scenery and ancient architecture, Gdynia is also a cultural city! The city is home to the Gdynia Film Festival, Poland's leading film festival. Since 2003, Gdynia has hosted the Open'er festival, one of Europe's biggest contemporary music festivals. It also hosts the annual Gdańsk Shakespeare Festival.

ADAPA Foundation works for the benefit of people with autism and other developmental disorders. We conduct vocational and social rehabilitation, therapeutic groups, interest clubs, offers consultations of specialists, therapeutic assistance and diagnosis. Mostly we are focused on the Occupational Therapy Workshop, where the process of social and vocational rehabilitation of people with intellectual and developmental disabilities takes place. Volunteers in ADAPA foundation are part of our team so they always have important roles. The work in each workshop consists of assisting the therapists during the classes and supporting the participants while they work. - Miscellaneous Crafts decorations for all occasions, later sold at various fairs,
- Computer and Information Technology basic functions of computer programmes and their operation,
- Printing creating badges, stickers, binding, laminating, and other similar works,

- Everyday Life Workshop - learning to cope with all the challenges of the so-called 'everyday life'. In addition to learn practical activities, our participants can develop their passions in the interest clubs that we run: Yoga, Drummers, Drama, Basketball, City Explorers and the TUS Club (social skills training for high-functioning people with ASD). Through our actions and promotional activities, the Foundation influences public opinion and awareness. Our purpose is to fully integrate people with disabilities in every aspect of life in society.

Wymiennikowia is the Youth Center for Social Innovation and Design, but we call this place just Wymiennikownia or WM, because it is shorter. Wymiennikownia is located in Gdynia, Chylonia district which is a nice, green area, close to the forest, not too far from the beach. This is a place for all people aged 13-35. It is a space for young people to connect and explore their interests in a welcoming and supportive environment, where they can take part in various events or just come and have a nice time. In Wymiennikownia, participants have a real impact on its functioning, they decide what classes they want to take part in or organize them themselves. Our dedicated employees and volunteers help in these activities. All the services are free of charge.

Wymiennikownia operates as part of the Social Innovation Laboratory in Gdynia, a budgetary unit of the City of Gdynia.

There are a lot of creative workshops in Wymiennikownia. Every week we do something different. Therefore, being creative and open-minded is crucial. All activities within the weekly schedule (such as drawing class, breakdance, karate, KPOP, yoga, dancehall etc.) **are run by young people for young people. This is a place where all the participants have their say and where they can implement their ideas.** A volunteer must be a person who understands the needs of youth and wants to do something with and for them.
