Our Youth Information Service aims to empower young citizens by providing relevant content and services. Whether it's about traveling abroad, job searching, or finding leisure activities, we offer reliable information and personalized advice, all free of charge. Young people can connect with us online, over the phone, or in person at our Info Service in Graz. Additionally, we provide various activities, including volunteering projects for young people, as well as networking opportunities for youth work professionals.

Role of the volunteer

Volunteer-specific tasks include:

- Planning and creating engaging content for our social media platforms, including videos, images, and text posts.
- Actively staying up to date with social media trends and analyzing their relevance to our audience.
- Capturing videos and photos as well as working in front of the camera for video content.
- Editing videos using mobile applications (such as CapCut, Filmora, etc.) and computer programs (such as Adobe Premiere Pro).
- Designing digital content and print products.
- Assisting in the organization of events and meetings, both online and offline.

- Supporting back-office tasks.
- Assisting in the coordination of European Solidarity Corps (ESC) volunteering activities.
- Promoting our activities by sharing relevant content on social media platforms.
- Participating actively in team meetings and offering help where needed.
- Planning and implementing your own project to contribute to our goals and objectives.

Profile of a Volunteer: Interested in social media and youth topics; enjoys working with a (phone)camera and creating engaging content; quick learner in using digital tools and applications; communicative and active, engaging with various groups of people; helpful and reliable team player, willing to assist in office tasks and event management; creative and initiative-taking, ready to work independently.

Volunteer's Benefits: LOGO will provide the volunteer with accommodation in a student dormitory. Food allowance and pocket money are provided according to program guidelines. The volunteer will receive a yearly transport ticket for the region of Austria and a bike.

Training and Support: The volunteer will receive at least an On-Arrival Training and a Mid-Term Training, organized by the Austrian National Agency. Volunteers will have the opportunity to attend German courses. Ongoing support will be provided by experienced colleagues.
